HOME HEATING TIME-OF-DAY (OFF-PEAK)

Rate Code: A-TOD

APPLICABLE:

To residential consumers within the service area of the Association, subject to the rules and regulations of the Association and of regulatory authorities, where consumer has installed Association-approved storage heating equipment.

AVAILABLE:

To all urban and rural areas.

TYPE OF SERVICE:

Single-phase, 60 hertz, at available secondary voltage.

MONTHLY RATE:

WINTER (October through March)

Facilities Charge:	\$39.25 per month for single-phase service
Energy Charge:	
On-Peak:	\$0.13896 per kWh
Off-Peak:	\$0.06116 per kWh

SUMMER (April through September)

Facilities Charge:	\$34.25 per month for single-phase service
Energy Charge:	\$0.12433 per kWh

DEFINITION OF ON-PEAK:

The winter on-peak period is from 12:00 PM through 10:00 PM every day during the months of September through April. Off-peak Hours are all hours not specified as on-peak.

MINIMUM BILL:

The monthly minimum bill shall be the highest of the following, subject to the provisions of the line extension policies:


- A. \$39.25 plus the charge for energy used, where fifty (50) kVA or less of transformer capacity is required; or
- B. Where a consumer requires more than 50 kVA of transformer capacity, \$39.25 plus the charge for energy used, which charge shall not be less than \$1.00 per kVA or fraction thereof above 50 kVA of transformer capacity; or
- B. As specified in contract for service.

HOME HEATING TIME-OF-DAY (OFF-PEAK) (Continued)

Rate Code: A-TOD

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

- A. The Association will read the meter on a monthly basis. However, in remote areas where weather conditions may prevent normal access by Association personnel, the following options will apply:
 - 1. The consumer will receive specific instructions in order to obtain meter readings and will be required to submit meter readings on a monthly basis. The standard Customer Charge will apply.
 - 2. The Association will read the meter on a monthly basis utilizing the required equipment to gain access and the consumer's facility charge will be as specified for remote locations.
- B. The consumer will be required to install Association-approved storage heating equipment.
- C. The House Heating Time-of-Day contract may be canceled by agreement of both parties. If the contract is canceled, the consumer no longer is qualified to receive service under this rate and will be billed under the standard applicable rate.
- D. The consumer will be required to meet with a qualified Association employee for explanation of this rate prior to signing a contract.
- E. All facilities beyond the meter shall be the consumer's obligation.
- F. The Association may require that motors of 10 HP or more be served three-phase.
- G. Three-phase service will not be provided for a service consisting of less than 10 HP.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

Payment for all bills for electric service must be postmarked ten (10) days following the date of bill mailing. Bills not paid by the next following bill date may be assessed a one and one-half percent (1.5%) late payment charge. This charge will be on the delinquent balance brought forward on the subsequent month's bill.

Payments received shall satisfy the oldest portion of the billing first.

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
